Manuscript requirements

The design elements of the text are:

- UDC
- the title of the article
- information about the author or authors
- abstract (summary)
- keywords (3-6 keywords)
- the text of the paper
- acknowledgments
- references
- attachments (if necessary)

Author information includes:

- surname, names, patronymic (if any) of the author; academic degree, academic title
- the name of the organization (institution) and its division where the author works or studies (without indicating the legal form of the legal entity: FSAEI HE, PJSC, JSC, etc.), city and country
- the author's email address (e-mail)
- ORCID

Text Formatting Rules:

Language: Russian or English, Times New Roman 14, size -1, full justification, paragraph -1.25 cm. Margins on each side -2 cm. Notes should be formatted as paginal footnotes, consecutive numbering. Please do not use end footnotes. Links to the List of References inside the text should be placed in square brackets [1, p. 1].

Text should be from 4 to 8 pages.
